Prompts for Creative Non-Fiction Writers

I Remember...: Start writing with the phrase, 'I remember...' and free write about whatever memory comes to you first.

Firsts: Write about your first time at something. It can be a first birthday, first fight, first day of school or work, whatever 'first' interests you most.

Have Faith: Write about faith, yours or someone else's, and what it means to you to be 'faithful'.
